



**Pediatric Lymphedema Interactive Workshop**

This 3.5 hour workshop, in English, will be led by **Dr. Isabelle Quéré**, Professor of Vascular Medicine at the University of Montpellier in France where she is Head of the Vascular and Lymphology Medicine Department and **Dr. Catherine McCuaig** a pediatric dermatologist managing vascular anomalies including lymphedema at CHU Sainte-Justine, University of Montreal. We are targeting to have 15-20 participants registered for the workshop from Canada, England, Ireland and France.

**When:** Friday morning, October 27 from 8:30am – 12:00pm

**Where:** Omni Mont-Royal Hotel, Montreal, Quebec

**Format:** An interactive session reviewing case studies, exchanging different treatment protocol and sharing best practices around the world.

**Other opportunities:** we encourage pediatric lymphedema specialists to also submit an abstract regarding their work with children and/or case studies. All abstracts will be reviewed by the Conference Scientific Committee, with accepted abstracts to be presented on Friday afternoon or Saturday. The abstract deadline is March 31, 2017.
